Language requirements	A sufficient level of German language is strongly recommended as lectures are usually held in German. It is also strongly recommended to attend a German course during the exchange in Linz. At least we expect a profound knowledge of English language from the students.
Language courses	Incoming exchange students can attend German courses offered by KUNI Linz – free of charge. Health insurance requirements	Students are obliged to have a sufficient health insurance valid in Austria during their stay as exchange students. Students have to take care of appropriate health insurance by themselves. The Austrian Student Union's fee (compulsory for all students enrolled at Austrian Universities) covers a liability insurance and an accidence insurance for damages and accidents in the University's sites and on the way from home to the University – about Euro 20, per semester
