Nomination from your home university	The first step to apply for an exchange semester at Nord University is to be nominated by your home university. Please note that nomination is not the same as admission.
Complete student exchange application form online	After nomination the next step is for you to fill out our online application form <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Your name should be written the same way as in your Passport/ID card- Your complete home address is required
Course information	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Information about our courses and study programmes in English can be found on our website- You should choose courses from one campus only as there is long distances between our different campuses- If you have any questions about the course selection you may contact our faculty coordinators. Changes to courses after your application must be agreed by both your home institution and Nord University
Course load per semester	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Full time studies are 30 ECTS per semester- You can read more about study permit requirements set by The Norwegian Directorate of Immigration on the their website
Send us required documents for your application	Required application documents: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Copy of Passport/ID card (encrypted)- Learning Agreement (for Erasmus+ students)- Official Transcript of records from home institution

Change of plans?	Should you for any reason decide not to study at Nord University it would be great if you could inform us as soon as possible.
